

## DECON MANIFOLD SYSTEM HDS-6016

The Decon Manifold System is a device that reduces the flow of water from a 1  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fire Hose to a series of three  $\frac{3}{4}$ " spigots. Garden hoses can be attached directly to the manifold and run to a Decon Shower or used separately.

Follow these easy steps to assure maximum effectiveness:

- 1. Connect fire hose supply line to  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " National Hose female swivel adapter.
- 2. Connect garden hose to  $\frac{3}{4}$ " brass spigot.
- 3. Run garden hose to Decon Shower, other decontamination equipment, or use hose separately.
- 4. Open up at least one brass spigot **PRIOR** to pressurizing manifold.
- 5. Pressurize the fire hose and connecting manifold.

CAUTION: MAXIMUM WATER PRESSURE TO MANIFOLD 60-80 psi

- 6. Once the system is pressurized, close any unnecessary spigots.
- 7. After use, turn off the source of water pressure to the manifold.
- 8. Once pressure is released, turn off spigots.
